Drugs, Myths, and Policy/Politics (not to Mention Sex)

SUMMARY: The invited lecture builds upon the author's experience in the position of the national drug coordinator of the Czech Republic and the chairman of the Horizontal Drugs Group (HDG) at the Council of the European Union during the Czech presidency of this top European institution.
